Gospel **Mark 10:46-55**

'Rabbuni,' the blind man said to him 'Master, let me see again.' Jesus said to him, 'Go; your faith has saved you.' And immediately his sight returned and he followed him along the road.

This week is a highlight for our Year 6 students as they go off to Camp for 3 days. The students participate in a number of activities, including visiting the Caves and raft building.

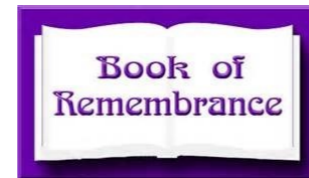
